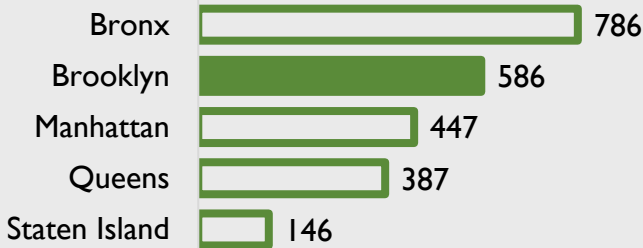


# Overdose Deaths Among Brooklyn Residents, 2021

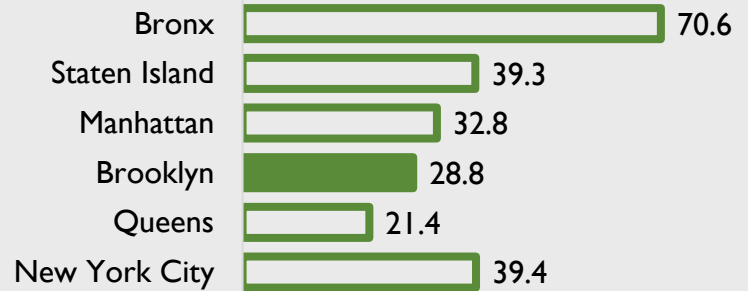
**586** Brooklyn residents died of a drug overdose.

Brooklyn residents had the second largest number of overdose deaths.

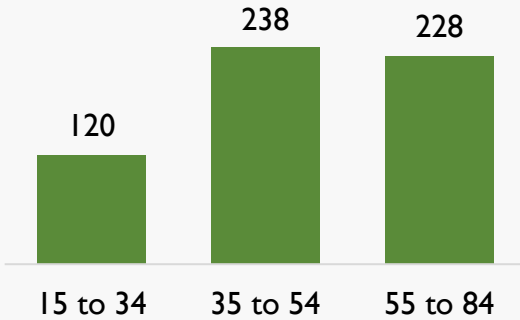


**28.8** residents per 100,000 died of a drug overdose.

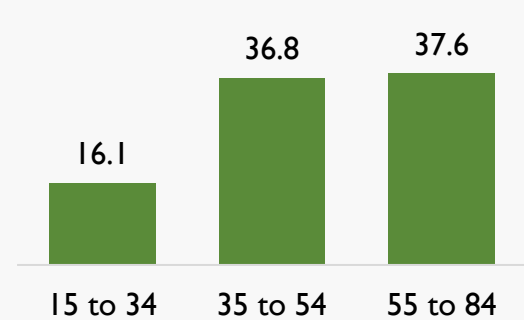
Brooklyn residents had the second lowest rate of overdose death.



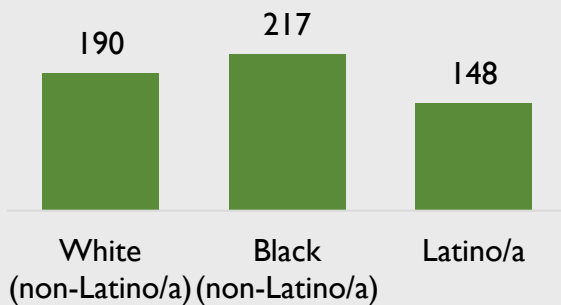
Brooklyn residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.



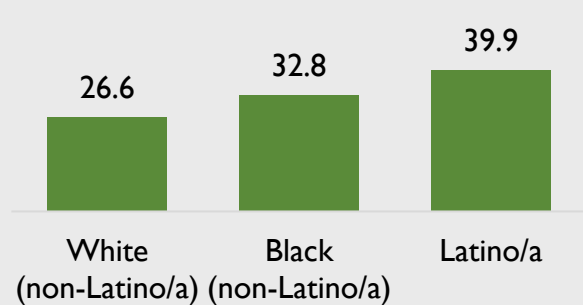
Brooklyn residents ages 55 to 84 had the highest rate of overdose death.



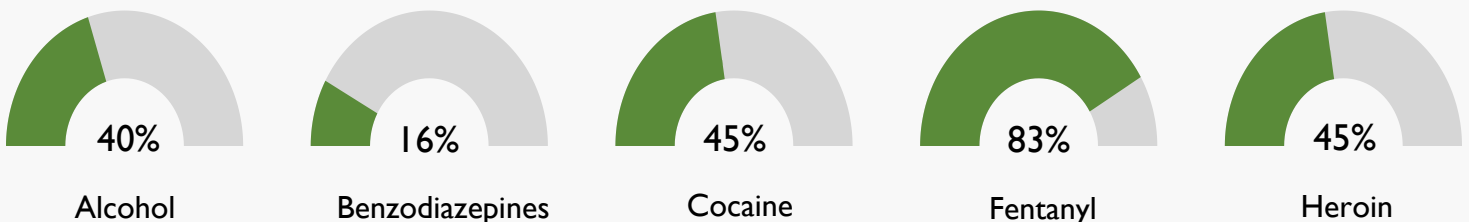
Black Brooklyn residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
