Provide Technical Assistance:

- Support efforts to link youth/family to the most conducive aftercare plan including appropriate school setting.
- Provide referrals to Evidence-based Preventive Services
- Case specific consultation.
- Provide resources/linkages to internal supportive ACS units
- Participate in family team conferences and case specific conferences

IPAS-CW, Residential and Preventive Provider Collaboration:

- Maintain ongoing dialogue in support of eligibility, treatment goals, and to prevent interruption of treatment.
- Provide clarity regarding the role and responsibility of each stakeholder
- Collaborate with Family Service Unit/Division of Child Protection, when required.

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
