## Who can benefit from B2H?

If your child has a serious emotional disturbance, developmental disability, or a serious medical problem, Bridges to Health (B2H) can help you get the services you need.

B2H is community based and offers freedom of choice to children and their families.

## To be eligible children must be:

1. In the custody of the Department of Social Service, Office of Children and Family Services or the Division of Juvenile Justice and Opportunities for Youth
2. Be eligible for Medicaid
3. Have a qualifying diagnosis
