Department of Investigation's Commissioner Jocelyn Strauber. Department of Consumer and Worker Protection Commissioner Vilda Vera Mayuga, who is joining us virtually. Department of Small Business Services General Counsel Anthony Dell'Olio, representing SBS Commissioner Kevin Kim. And Inspector Osvaldo Nunez of the New York City Police Department representing Police Commissioner Edward Caban.

Today the Commission will consider the application filed by Mike's Heavy Duty Towing, Inc. for a trade waste registration.

The staff has investigated the application and had prepared a recommendation that the application be denied based on two independently sufficient grounds.

One, the applicant and/or principal, Michael Mazzio, has been indicted for bribery, conspiracy to form a monopoly, and offering a false instrument for filing.

And, two, the applicant failed to notify the Commission of Principal Michael Mazzio's arrest, the applicant's, criminal charges and their conviction.

The applicant was served with the staff's recommendation. The applicant was advised that it had ten business days to submit a sworn written response to the Commission. The Commission did not receive a response from the applicant.

On January 26, 2024, we provided the Commissioners with the draft denial decision regarding this application, and the matter is now ready for a vote.

The Commission will now consider the recommendation. The Commissioners will vote on whether to deny the application. A vote of yes is a vote to adopt the staff's denial recommendation; a vote of no is a vote not to adopt the recommendation.

Is there a motion from the Commissioners to adopt the staff's recommendation?


