DRIVER DAILY VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORTS (DVIR)

- DRIVERS MUST PREPARE A DAILY INSPECTION REPORT
- DRIVER MUST REVIEW THE MOST RECENT REPORT AND DETERMINE WHETHER REQUIRED REPAIRS HAVE BEEN MADE
- LICENSEES AND REGISTRANTS MUST MAINTAIN COPIES OF ALL DAILY INSPECTION REPORTS REQUIRED FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) YEARS
- COPIES OF REPORTS (PAPER OR ELECTRONIC) MUST BE AVAILABLE IN THE CORRESPONDING VEHICLES AT ALL TIMES FOR FOURTEEN (14) DAYS

DVIRS MUST IDENTIFY ANY SAFETY DEFECTS <u>AND</u> COVER:

- SERVICE AND PARKING BRAKES
- STEERING MECHANISM
- TIRES, WHEELS AND RIMS
- SIDE GUARDS
- COUPLING DEVICES
- MIRRORS
- LIGHTING DEVICES AND REFLECTORS
- Horn
- WINDSHIELD WIPERS
- EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT



6-Month Qualified Inspector Reports

- VEHICLES MUST PASS AN INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY A QUALIFIED INSPECTOR AT LEAST ONCE DURING THE PRECEDING SIX MONTHS
 - "QUALIFIED INSPECTOR" DEFINITION FROM THE US DOT FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION.
- COPIES OF THE MOST RECENT REPORT (PAPER OR ELECTRONIC) MUST BE KEPT IN THE CORRESPONDING VEHICLE FOR AT LEAST SIX (6) MONTHS
- LICENSEES AND REGISTRANTS MUST MAINTAIN COPIES
 OF ALL INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION OF REPAIR
 FORMS REQUIRED FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) YEARS

QUALIFIED INSPECTOR REPORT MUST IDENTIFY ANY SAFETY DEFECTS <u>AND</u> COVER:

- SERVICE AND PARKING BRAKES
- STEERING MECHANISM
- TIRES, WHEELS AND RIMS
- SIDE GUARDS
- COUPLING DEVICES
- Mirrors
- LIGHTING DEVICES AND REFLECTORS
- Horn
- WINDSHIELD WIPERS
- EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT



Qualified Inspector Definition

§ 396.19 Inspector qualifications.

- (a) Motor carriers and intermodal equipment providers must ensure that individuals performing annual inspections under § 396.17(d) or (e) are qualified as follows:
 - Understand the inspection criteria set forth in part 393 and appendix A to this part and can identify defective components;
 - (2) Are knowledgeable of and have mastered the methods, procedures, tools and equipment used when performing an inspection; and
 - (3) Are capable of performing an inspection by reason of experience, training, or both as follows:
 - Successfully completed a Federal-or State-sponsored training program or have a certificate from a State or Canadian Province that qualifies the individuals to perform commercial motor vehicle safety inspections, or
 - (ii) Have a combination of training or experience totaling at least 1 year. Such training or experience may consist of:
 - (A) Participation in a commercial motor vehicle manufacturer-sponsored training program or similar commercial training program designed to train students in commercial motor vehicle operation and maintenance;
 - (B) Experience as a mechanic or inspector in a motor carrier or intermodal equipment maintenance program;
 - (C) Experience as a mechanic or inspector in commercial motor vehicle maintenance at a commercial garage, fleet leasing company, or similar facility; or
 - (D) Experience as a commercial motor vehicle inspector for a State, Provincial or Federal government.

 - EASY TO KEEP THE PORTAL UPDATED AS DRIVERS ARE HIRED



Licensee: Submit information for all trade waste drivers and helpers. . Registrant: Submit information for all trade waste drivers. For each vehicle operator, please upload: · A clear copy of the operator's driver's license. AND, for all vehicle operators whose driver's license is not issued by New York State, you must provide an official driving record (abstract) from the state that issued the driver's license. All fields are required to be fully and accurately completed. A Missing Information symbol (🛕) will appear next to each employee's record when there is information missing for that particular individual. Keep this module up to date. It must reflect the current roster of all vehicle operators and helpers for your company. Update the module when: · a vehicle operator's or helper's employment status changes, · upon hiring a new vehicle operator or helper, · any other relevant changes to the information. on the driver portal.
