IMPORTANT ALERT SCAM/PHISHING CAMPAIGN MIMICKING BIC EMAILS

To all licensees and registrants:

BIC is alerting the industry to a **phishing campaign designed to steal login credentials**. The phishing emails mimic BIC emails, and reference an attached "secure document" from "webmail@bic.nyc.gov". These emails are **NOT LEGITIMATE**. BIC does not send emails from "webmail@bic.nyc.gov". **The phishing email may be or look like the attached PDF**. If you receive such an email, please **do not open any attached documents or click any links; instead, delete it immediately**.

Legitimate BIC directives and notices are sent from bnotifications@bic.nyc.gov. Attachments sent from this email address are safe and from BIC.

If you received the scam email and clicked any links in the email, you are advised to **reset your BIC Online Portal account password** by going to the <u>login page</u> and selecting "Reset Your Password" or emailing BIC IT at <u>portalsupport@bic.nyc.gov</u>.
