This variance allows for inmates aged 18 through 21 to be housed together with inmates over the age of 21 in the following specialized units: the RMSC infirmary, RMSC nursery, and RMSC pregnant inmate housing.¹

¹ On November 10, 2015, the NYC Board of Correction ("Board") granted a request submitted by the NYC Health + Hospitals for a continuing variance from the BOC Minimum Standards §1-02(c)(1), which required that "no later than October 15, 2015...inmates ages 18 through 21 be housed separately and apart from inmates over the age of 21." The variance allowed for inmates from these two age groups to be housed together in specialized mental health units--including but not limited to the Program for Accelerating Clinical Effectiveness (PACE) and Clinical Alternative to Punitive Segregation (CAPS) units and for the provision of services through the KEEP program at Anna M. Kross Center (AMKC)—and in the NIC infirmary and WF communicable disease unit (CDU).
