We as a people are dealing with difficult time concerning this Covid-19 pandemic. Us here at U.C.B.C. in housing unit 2cB are having a tuff time adjusting to dealing with keeping ourselves safe. We (detainees) find it hard to social distance in a dorm that holds 50 beds and 43 of those beds are filled with less than 6 feet of space between those beds. We are in a dorm that have no windows that open up, so any air born illness that's floating around just recycles. We have a ventilation system that works sometimes and sometimes it does not work. The c/o's and captians tell us "If somebody sit's next to you tell them to move or get away" to promote social distance. Telling another person to move or get away from you, in this environment could potentially cause an altercation, which I personally don't want to do because I'm am trying to stay clear of any altercations. US (detainees)

have serious cases and we are trying to do our best to get information on our cases so we can help our lawyers, but it's hard to do that when we can't leave the dorm for law library services. We (detainees) send requests down to law ~~to~~ library so they can help us retrieve the information we need, but they either send half or less than half of the information we ask for or they send the request form back saying "They can't get these things copied" or they just don't send anything back and we have to just re-submit our request form.
