- 1. New Liquor License Application(s):
  - a. La Parranda Bar & Restaurant Inc. 2712 White Plains Road: Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider.

The applicant was present. 49<sup>th</sup> Precinct was consulted and had no issues.

The applicant consented to sign an agreement to only serve alcohol:

Sunday to Wednesday: 12 PM to 12 AM Thursday to Saturday: 12 PM to 1 AM

Motion by Dominick Schiano, Seconded by Sandra Unger – Community Board 11 will send an email of *No Objection* to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.** 

b. Uncle Jocko's Banquet Hall Inc. – 2415 East Tremont Avenue: Wine, Beer, and Cider.

The applicant was present. The 49<sup>th</sup> Precinct was consulted. Lieutenant Hickman clarified ABC law enforcement and Cabaret License requirements. Applicant stated that property area is a Zone 3 not Zone 4 so it is not zoned for cabaret licenses.

Applicant was asked to sign an agreement to serve alcohol:

Sunday to Wednesday: 12 PM to 12 AM Thursday to Saturday: 12 PM to 1 AM

The matter was tabled to February 2<sup>nd</sup>.

b. Pelham Bay Diner – 1920 E. Gun Hill Road: Liquor, Wine, Bee, and Cider.

Applicant was present. 49<sup>th</sup> Precinct was consulted and had no issues.

Motion by Dominick Schiano, Seconded by Sandra Unger – Community Board 11 will send an email of *No Objection* to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.** 

c. Williamsbridge Tavern – 1556 Williamsbridge Road: Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider.

Applicant was present. 49<sup>th</sup> Precinct was consulted and advised that the night before the committee meeting, the precinct sent in an underage person to the establishment and that person was sold a beer. The bartender was arrested for this offense.

- Two (2) offenses were for serving alcohol to a minor (most recent stated above).
- One (1) offense for liquor license not being posted.

Applicant was present. 49<sup>th</sup> Precinct was consulted and had no issues.
