Meeting began with Mr. Greg Rodriguez discussing why and when for proposing a new college preparatory charter high school for the Bronx in School Districts 8 and 12 including some of CB11 and CB10, serving Grade 9 in 2018-19 school years. Proposed opening date is August 2018. Letter of Intent will be submitted January 25, 2017. Grade levels will be 9 to 12, phasing in year by year with 100 students in August 2018 with 500 at full capacity. This charter school is not part of the CMO (Charter Management Organization) but an individual charter, School Empowerment Network (SEN). Mr. Rodriguez's past experience has been with the UFT Charter School in Brooklyn, 7yrs with Fanny Lou HS in Brooklyn and 4 years as AP with Westchester Square Academy.
