1. Renewal Liquor License Application(s):

- a. Golden Eagle Restaurant Inc. – 975 Morris Park Avenue: Liquor, Wine, Beer, & Cider.

Applicant was present. 49th Precinct was consulted and had no objection.

Motion by Veronica Castro, Seconded by Shradhanand Pirtam – that Community Board 11 send an e-mail of **No Objection** to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.**

2. New Liquor License Application(s):

Eno’s Club Café Inc. – 741 Astor Avenue: Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider.

Applicant was not present but sent a representative. 49th Precinct was consulted. Establishment has had several issues including warehousing liquor without having a liquor license.

Motion by Veronica Castro, Seconded by Shradhanand Pirtam – that Community Board 11 send an e-mail of **Objection** to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.**

- a. The Hunting Club Inc. – 2503 Williamsbridge Road: Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider.

Applicant was present. 49th Precinct was consulted. There have been several summonses issued for the establishment but it was during the time it was under a different manager. Applicant provided copy of lease to show that he has been there only since August 2017.

Motion by Shradhanand Pirtam, Seconded by Sandra Unger – that Community Board 11 send an e-mail of *No Objection* to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **PASSED with 1 objection.**

b. Sofra NY LLC, 2011A Williamsbridge Rd.: Wine & Beer

Applicant was present. 49th Precinct was consulted and had no objection.

Motion by Veronica Castro, Seconded by Shradhanand Pirtam – that Community Board 11 send an e-mail of *No Objection* to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) regarding this establishment. **UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.**
