**3. DOT Presentation: Bronxdale Avenue Safety Improvements (Preliminary Proposal)**

DOT has identified issues along Bronxdale Avenue b/w Bronx Park East to East Tremont Avenue that require restructuring & restriping. They have identified 167 injuries on Bronxdale Avenue b/w 2012-2016. DOT is currently gathering data/feedback from community stakeholders before moving forward with a final proposal. DOT will return in the late fall after collecting data. The committee has asked that they meet with varying associations and businesses including Van Nest Neighborhood Assn., Morris Park Assn., White Plains Road, & Pelham Parkway Assn. CB11 has

a copy of the proposal that will be circulated to the full board. Installation of bike lanes is also part of the initial DOT proposal.
