
Organize Traffic Flow

Improve Safety for All Users

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements on Baychester Ave. between Boston Rd. and E 233 St./Grenada Pl.:

- Construct pedestrian safety islands at Schieffelin Ave., Crawford Ave., and E 233 St.
- Install left turn bays on Baychester Ave. at Schieffelin Ave. and Crawford Ave.
- Install two new traffic signals and crosswalks on Baychester Ave. between Schieffelin Ave.
 and Needham Ave.
- Convert Grenada Pl. to one-way eastbound between Edson Ave. and Baychester Ave.
- Change signal timing at Baychester Ave. and E 233 St./Grenada Pl. to provide additional pedestrian crossing time
- Simplify signal display and lane markings for northbound traffic on Baychester Ave.
- Install back-in angled parking on Grenada Pl. between Edson Ave. and Baychester Ave.

Implementation starts in August
