 - · Advocate to elected officials for an increase in sanitation enforcement personnel to address violations of dirty sidewalks by merchants, street vendors, and homeowners.
 - o Include BIDs to help with educating and outreach to commercial owners.
 - · Canine waste laws members would like to distribute dog waste bags and metal signs at any upcoming community events, contingent on budget and ability to procure in a timely manner.
 - o NYC DEP initiating outreach about the proper ways to dispose of dog waste in catch basins and sewers that ends up in the waterways. Would like to attend any Pet events where the message can be disseminated.
 - · Advocate for more frequent cleaning of catch basins.
