A. DSNY Issues

- 1. School trash is picked up at least once daily; recyclables on Kingsbridge road are not being picked up. This will be Followed-up.
- 2. Starting this Fall, religious institutions will be required to follow the same sanitation rules as residents.
- 3. Betty will follow up with the Small Businesses Merchant's Association & BIDS regarding having a private hauler for trash.

 From Sirio Guerrino: Can merchants share a carter?

 Yes, they can. Businesses can share a carter and their garbage.

B. Updates from Chair Arce -

- 1. Commercial containerization-As of 3/1/24, businesses must have containers with attached lids; either with a hinge or attached by a chain. All the garbage must be in a container. Further, in 2 years there will be a standard container that must be used.
 - a) Question from Sirio: What enforcement will there be for businesses? Answer: There will be a one month grace period before DSNY issues fines to non-compliant stores.
 - b) Question from Kazi: *How are businesses being notified?* Kazi noted that the Flyer was not clear, it only stated to call 311 with questions. **Answer:** Chair advised that comments be sent to the DM with concerns. Helene also suggested that notices be sent via mail to the stores but there is concern that the owners of the property would receive the mail and not the renters who need the information. It was then suggested to meet with the Bids and the Merchants association for follow up
- 2. Requests for Smart Bins for organic waste should be sent to Betty Arce.
- f. Chair reported that moving forward the area will be broken down into zones, where different carters will be responsible for their zones.

C. Capital Expenses- the committee reviewed request for 2025

1. Catch basin issues- the committee suggests more frequent cleaning at certain areas because all basins are cleaned every two years and this can be a problem for any basins that smell and are in need of attention.



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2. Canine enforcement: There was a long and involved discussion on enforcement and what can be done to cut down on this problem. There are only two enforcement agents for the entire borough. The committee suggests to look for other alternatives to address this issue.
