

District Service Cabinet Summary October 17, 2023 - 1:00 PM

Description: The City Charter establishes a District Service Cabinet (DSC) in each community district, to be composed of agency officials responsible for local service delivery. The District Manager of the Community Board chairs the District Service Cabinet, whose members include representatives of the agencies that deliver local services to the Community District. The District Service Cabinet is the primary mechanism through which local service delivery issues can be raised, discussed and resolved. If used effectively, the Cabinet can provide the basis for a comprehensive approach to service delivery within the community district.

- Unionport Bridge, Rachel Zurita
 Work activities completed for Unionport Bridge:
- Installed structural steel at the north deck over the counterweight structure.
- Placed permanent concrete to reconstruct Brush Ave.
- Installed steel face curb at the turnaround between west and east Bruckner Blvd.
- Placed concrete for the east approach parapet.
- Installed guard rail on westbound Bruckner Blvd & east of Brush Ave.
- Installed overhead sign structures between Brush Ave & Zerega Ave, as well as east of Brush Ave.
- Installed bridge railing at the south bascule span.
- Painted north bascule span steel.

Upcoming work for Unionport Bridge:

- Continue installation of fender panels (these panels protect/prevent impact to the bridge from marine traffic).
- Continue installation of bridge railing at eastbound/westbound Bruckner Blvd & Zerega Ave.
- Continue steel installation at the north bascule span.
- Continue installation of rebar and concrete placement for the east approach parapet.
- Continue installation of machinery at the bascule pier and control house.
