

# District Service Cabinet Summary February 13, 2024 - 1:00 PM

**Description:** The City Charter establishes a District Service Cabinet (DSC) in each community district, to be composed of agency officials responsible for local service delivery. The District Manager of the Community Board chairs the District Service Cabinet, whose members include representatives of the agencies that deliver local services to the Community District. The District Service Cabinet is the primary mechanism through which local service delivery issues can be raised, discussed, and resolved. If used effectively, the Cabinet can provide the basis for a comprehensive approach to service delivery within the community district.

### I. Service Requests

#### 1. Parks/MTA

A. Update on Clason Pt Park Potential Swing Gate Closure- MTA would need this gate to be open at a requested time. The gate can be closed from 11pm to 6am, MTA needs the gate open so bus can do turnaround. Parks is waiting to see if the requested gate closure time is something they can accommodate. Sgt. Soriano stated that he would be interested in having keys to close the gate.

  - Continue testing/bridge opening of the south bascule span.
  - Continue installation of barrier gate at the east approach (between Westchester Creek & Brush Ave).
  - Continue formwork installation at the north deck of the bridge.

- Continue installation of bridge operating machinery for the north bascule span.
- Continue installation of machinery at the bascule pier and control house.

FDA also recommends that individuals test twice when using home-test, due to the risk of getting false negatives from user error, just FYI.
