Restrictions to Curbside Parking and Driveway Access

“NO PARKING” REGULATION AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS RESTRICTION ARE IN EFFECT PROJECT COTINUATION

On/about the week of September 26, 2016, the NYC Department of Design and Construction (DDC) will continue the Citywide Milling Project #HW2CR15CW. The anticipated completion date for the locations listed below is September 30, 2016.

WHERE WILL WORK BE PERFORMED?

Work will be performed at the following locations:

- Poly Place between 7th Avenue and 14th Avenue/Cropsey Avenue
- 7th Avenue between Poly Place and 86th Street
- 88th Street between Parrot Place and 7th Avenue
- Parrot Place between 7th Avenue and 88th Street
- 7th Avenue between 86th Street and Fort Hamilton Parkway
- Fort Hamilton Parkway between 7th Avenue and 81st Street
- 7th Avenue between 78th Street/Fort Hamilton Parkway and 72nd Street
- Fort Hamilton Parkway between Bayridge Parkway and 7th Avenue

WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

Work scheduled on this project includes the milling of streets in preparation for resurfacing by the NYC Department of Transportation Roadway Repair & Maintenance (RRM) division.



WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

The DDC is committed to maintaining a work site that is safe and clean. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project. There may be limited street access on certain blocks. However, deliveries to residential properties and emergency vehicle access will be allowed.

Pedestrian / Traffic

- ❖ Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.
- ❖ Street closures may be required; warning signs will be posted in advance.
- ❖ Driveway access may be temporarily interrupted in order to complete construction.

Public Transportation

- ❖ If/when necessary, bus stops and/or bus routes may be relocated/detoured during the course of this construction. Signs and directions will be posted noting the changes.

No Parking Notification

- ❖ Dedicated "No Parking" signs will be posted in all affected areas for the specific day/days for this work operation.

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF WORK?

Typical work hours will be Monday-Friday from 8:00pm to 5:00am.
