

**REPLACEMENT OF THE EXISTING WATER SIPHONS
BETWEEN BROOKLYN AND STATEN ISLAND**

Notice of Upcoming Work – Street Restoration

<u>LOCATION:</u>	Shore Road and 79th Street
<u>SCHEDULE:</u>	beginning the week of October 10th and continuing for approximately eight (8) weeks (weather permitting)
<u>TIME:</u>	typically weekdays from approximately 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
	<u>NOTE:</u> As this work is weather dependent, the contractor may work up to 10 hours a day and on Saturdays, if necessary.

As part of its ongoing work on the Siphon Project, the New York City Economic Development Corporation will be restoring sections of Shore Road and 79th Street that were disturbed during the installation of new water mains, sewers and associated activities.

Upcoming work includes installation of catch basins; placement of manholes; replacement of curbs and sidewalks impacted by construction; excavation of the existing pavement; grading and compaction of soil; placement of base concrete/asphalt; and curing/hardening of the new roadway surface. Final paving of Shore Road will be performed one half width at a time. Although two lanes of Shore Road (one lane in each direction) will remain open at all times, there may be brief intermittent street closures. The intersection of 79th Street and Shore Road will also be subject to short-term closures during some work activities.

Please note that **access to some driveways is likely to be restricted intermittently (including overnight) for several days while the new sidewalks and roadway surfaces harden.** Pedestrian access to homes will be maintained at all times. We will provide advance notice to homeowners prior to limiting access to their driveways.

There will be NO PARKING on sections of Shore Road (approximately 78th to 80th Streets) and 79th Street (the end closest to Shore Road) while the street restoration is under way. Please look for and observe all flagpersons, “No Parking” signs and construction barriers so that work can be completed in a timely manner.

If anyone in your home has special access needs, call Anita Wright, the project’s community liaison at (646) 823-6588. Ms. Wright will be available to answer your questions, provide additional information and assist you in resolving construction-related issues. Although the project team will make every effort to minimize impacts during construction, some disruption and inconvenience typically occur on any construction project. These generally relate to changes to vehicular and pedestrian traffic patterns; loss of parking; and other construction-related impacts (noise, dust, etc.).
