The Brooklyn Community Board 6 Youth/Human Services/Education Committee is seeking to honor youth from the CB6 district who have made a substantial contribution to the improvement of the quality of life in our neighborhoods or who have served as a positive role model for others.

We would like to recognize and award as many active youth as possible from our community. Some may perform community service as a group, while others may have made outstanding individual contributions. In making your nomination, please think carefully if your nominee should be recognized:

- a. For his or her work as part of a group, and a group award given with individual certificates for each member, or
- b. Individually because the community service was unique, outstanding and done either outside of a group, or
- c. Individually because the community service performed, while the individual was part of a group, surpassed the service of others in the group in ways that you can detail and clearly express in your nomination.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Nominees must be between the ages of 10 to 19;
- They must reside, attend school or be involved in some community-based program in the Brooklyn Community Board 6 district;
- They must receive no stipends for their acts; and
- They must have performed their community service during the previous calendar year

APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATORS:

- Complete the Nomination Form on the back of this application.
- Make sure you *sign the completed form*.
- Make sure your form is postmarked no later than **April 7, 2017**. You may also fax [(718) 624-8410] or hand deliver forms to the District Office by that date.
- Only volunteers will be considered eligible for this award.
- All applications will be reviewed by a subcommittee of the CB6 Youth/Human Services/Education Committee. The subcommittee will select the recipients of the Youth Acknowledgement Award. The decision of the subcommittee is final.
- Recipients will be notified in April and will be expected to attend the CB6 general meeting at 6:15 pm on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 to receive their award.
