

UPCOMING CHANGE

2014 NYC Construction Codes: December 31, 2014 Effective Date

Mayor Bill de Blasio has signed Local Law 52 of 2014, changing the 2014 NYC Construction Codes' effective date to December 31, 2014.

This extension provides design professionals additional preparation time to ensure that plans and specifications comply with new provisions under the 2014 NYC Construction Codes.

This new effective date affects filings submitted on or after December 31, 2014, including:

- Limited Alteration Applications (LAA1)
- Plan Work Applications (PW1)
- Technical Report Statement of Responsibility (TR1)
- eFiling and HUB Self Service
- Special Inspection Agency Registration (SIA1)

All jobs (NBs, alts, etc.) filed on or prior to December 30, 2014 cannot select the 2014 Code.*

^{*}If a project is filed under the 2008 Code, it may be changed to a 2014 Code project by amendment on or after December 31, 2014.
