Format: AAA BB C D E F, as follows:

- A: UHC = Model Series
- B: P = PDA (Personal Data Assistant) Programmable
PN = Narrow P unit, 10.75 in. wide at base
- C: 2 or 4 = No. of Holding Slots
- D: T = "Traditional" Style with LED displays on both front and rear of cabinet
S = "S.P.O.D" style, single point of distribution with LED displays on single side only.
- E: P = Pin and Sleeve Connector
T = Twist Lock Attachment Plug Cap
- F: L = 4 in. Legs
Blank = No Legs

Terms and Conditions: That the above commercial electric universal holding cabinets, be accepted, under the following conditions:

1. Units shall be installed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and New York City Electrical Code requirements.
2. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a permanent tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and acceptable for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
3. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Bureau of Electrical Control before installation.
