Description: These units are electrically-operated proofing cabinets intended to be permanently connected to the electrical supply source and to be connected to a water source. The units are comprised of heaters with sheathed elements, contactors, regulating and limiting controls, and a stainless steel and aluminum enclosure. The sheathed elements are not subdivided above 48 amps due to a suitable enclosure. The maximum watt density of the ovens tested is 74 watts/cu. ft.
