Description – Commercial, electric convection ovens, as tabulated below. They are conveyORIZED, permanently connected, forced air convection ovens with all electrical components, except the fan and heating elements, in one compartment. An air pressure switch disconnects the heat if the fan stops. Each unit consists of thermostat, a cooling fan, a blower motor and a conveyor motor. Units shall be installed with 6 inches minimum clearance from any combustible surface. However, for service and cleaning, a minimum of 18 inches is recommended.
