

SUBJECT: Gasoline and Diesel Motor Fuel Tanks Filed in Connection
With Capital Construction Projects

Effective immediately on all Miscellaneous applications involving gasoline and diesel motor fuel tanks in connection with Capital Construction Projects, the Fire Department is to receive a copy of the application and plans upon approval by the plan examiner.

The plan examiner in addition to signing the original copy is also to sign the Fire Department's copy of the application which is to be clearly marked "THIS IS NOT A PERMIT". The Borough Superintendent's signature stamp is not to be placed on any copies of the application and plans indicating that the application becomes a work permit, until the contractor's name, address and Workman's Compensation Insurance policy number is indicated thereon. At such time the application is to be marked with a stamp "THIS IS A PERMIT TO PROCEED WITH THE WORK".
