

Instructions for Completing Crane & Derrick Applications

General Instructions

All Applications must be typed.
If additional space is required, please use 8 1/2 x 11 sheets and attach to the application.
Do NOT write on the back of any form.
Do NOT write in any block without a block number (i.e. Internal Use).

Crane Approval and Operation Application (CD-2)

<u>Section</u>	<u>Instructions</u>
1. Application Type	Check (X) the appropriate box.
2. CD Number	If the application type is renewal or change, provide the CD Number of the crane or derrick.
3. Applicant Information	Provide the name, title, address and phone number of the applicant and the crane owner
4. Crane or Derrick Information	Indicate (X) if the model has been granted Prototype approval. If so, provide its Prototype Number. Provide the name of the manufacturer, the model, model year and serial number of the crane or derrick. Check (X) the type of crane or derrick and the power type. If the type is not listed, provide it in the given box. Provide the number of drums, the wire size of each drum and indicate (X) if each is overwound or underwound.
5. Boom/Jib Information	Provide the boom type of the crane or derrick. Provide the maximum length of boom applied for including jibs and extensions. Provide the maximum length of the boom and the jib as recommended by the manufacturer. Provide the identification numbers of each boom section and each job section. List them in order from the lowest section to the highest section.
6. Crane/Derrick Dimensions	Provide the length, width and width with outriggers extended of the overall carrier. Provide the cross carriage overhang. If the application is for a tower or climber crane, provide the length, width and height of the tower. Also provide the identification numbers of the tower sections in order, from the lowest section to the highest section. If the application is for a derrick, provide the mast length and the identification numbers of the mast sections in order from the lowest section to the highest section.
7. Statements and Signatures	The applicant and the crane owner must each provide his name, and sign and date the application.
