SUBJECT: Accident Involving Cranes, Derricks and Scaffolds

The cooperation of the Police Department has been enlisted in notification when scaffold, crane or derrick accidents occur and in safeguarding accident sites. The Police Department T.O.P. 13 series of 1970 which details the precise action to be taken in the event of accidents has been issued to all Police Department personnel.

Upon notification of an accident the Chief Inspector of Construction-Operations or the inspectors on duty at the Emergency Desk shall notify the borough offices and the Director, Division of Cranes and Derricks in the manner outlined in Directive #5-1970 "Manual of Emergency Procedure." Inspection shall be conducted in a manner detailed in Directive #5 of 1970. Copies of Police Department T.O.P. #13 are attached.
