**Job Description**

The NYC Department of Buildings is responsible for ensuring the safe and lawful use of buildings and properties by enforcing the NYC Construction Codes, Energy Code and Zoning Resolution. We facilitate compliant development with integrity, efficiency and professionalism. We are committed to becoming a premier municipal building organization, dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for all New Yorkers and making our city safer. We are committed to improving our performance and developing procedures that are streamlined, understandable and transparent.

An Electrical Inspector will perform the following:

Technical work in the inspection of electrical installations, repairs or alterations to insure conformance to code, standards, plans or specifications. Issues violations and/or summonses for non-compliance.

Prepares accurate inspectorial reports.

Responds to telephone and in-person inquiries.

Accurately and professionally, provide expert testimony at administrative and criminal court hearings.

Candidates must successfully pass a drug screening to be appointed.

**Minimum Qualification Requirements**

- Five years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last 15 years as an electrician or inspector of electrical installations, light, heat, and/or power distribution, fire alarm detection or communication systems; or
- Three years of full-time satisfactory experience as described in 1 above, plus either 60 semester credits from an accredited college with a minimum of 12 credits in electrical related courses or two years of full-time training in an acceptable electrical program in an accredited technical school; or
- A license as a professional engineer or architect valid in the State of New York; or
- A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience that is equivalent to 1 or 2 above. Education may be substituted for experience on the basis that six months of full-time training in an electrical program in an accredited technical school or 15 semester credits in an accredited college is equivalent to six months of the experience described in 1 above. To be credited, college education must include at least 12 semester credits in electrical related courses. However, all candidates must have a minimum of three years of experience as described in 1 above.

**Additional Information**

A valid New York State Department of Motor Vehicles Driver's License maintained for the duration of employment. At the time of appointment, all candidates residing in New York City must apply to receive Special Patrolman status.
