

# UPCOMING CHANGE

## Lower Manhattan Construction + Truck Embargo September 5 – September 11, 2014

In preparation of this year's September 11<sup>th</sup> commemoration, a Department of Buildings and Department of Transportation Special Event Construction Embargo will be in effect in two areas of Lower Manhattan. Restrictions begin 6pm on Friday, September 5 and are in effect through 6pm on Thursday, September 11, 2014.

### Main Embargo & Additional Embargo Areas

#### **Boundaries:**

North: Vesey Street                      East: Broadway/ Greenwich Street & Trinity Place  
South: Battery Place                      West: West Street

**Dates:** 6:00pm Friday, September 5 – 11:59pm Wednesday, September 10, 2014

#### **Work Limitations:**

- Trucking: Trucks may enter, including trucks delivering construction material.
- Exterior Construction Work: No increase/expansion of barricades, barriers, fencing of work areas. All other work may proceed until 11:59pm Wednesday September 10.
- Interior Construction Work: Allowed, as per issued and valid permits.
- Work Behind Barriers: Allowed, as per issued and valid permits.

**Dates:** 12:00am Thursday, September 11 – 6:00pm Thursday, September 11, 2014

#### **Work Limitations:**

- Trucking: No trucks may enter, including trucks delivering construction material.
- Exterior Construction Work: Prohibited after 11:59pm Wednesday, September 10 (Including Crane Operations)
- Interior Construction Work: Allowed, as per issued and valid permits
- Work Behind Barriers: Prohibited after 11:59pm Wednesday, September 10

Non-emergency permits issued prior to September 5, 2014, are suspended, as outlined above. This embargo will be strictly enforced, and non-complying sites will be subject to violations.
