

SERVICE UPDATE

General Liability Insurance Required for Shed and Scaffold Job Types

Effective May 16, 2016, contractors or licensees pulling permits for shed or scaffold job types, must meet General Liability Insurance requirements by presenting proof of their \$1,000,000.00 insurance policy, in accordance with [1 RCNY 101-08](#).

If a contractor or licensee attempts to obtain a permit for shed or scaffold work but does not currently have \$1,000,000 in General Liability Insurance coverage, they will be instructed to obtain the coverage and present proof of the insurance policy to the Licensing Unit – after which they will be able to obtain a permit.
