Inspection Ready: Crane Owner Update

In accordance with the technology enhancements outlined in our *Building One City* plan, the Department of Buildings has launched Inspection Ready, our new online inspection request and routing system. Inspection Ready will allow job applicants, permit holders and owners to request development inspections online:

- Electrical
- Fire Suppression
- Construction
- Elevators
- Oil Burning Equipment
- Plumbing
- Signs
- Boilers
- Cranes & Derricks
- BPP
- Sustainability
- High Rise Initiative

Crane Owners

To request inspections and upload required documents, crane owners must be linked to their devices in Inspection Ready.

To link to devices, crane owners should complete the following:

- 1) Register for Inspection Ready at: <https://a810-Impaca.nyc.gov/CitizenAccessBuildings/>
- 2) Once registration is complete, scan and email a completed [CD11](mailto:cranesandderricksIR@buildings.nyc.gov) form to cranesandderricksIR@buildings.nyc.gov
- 3) Once this information is received, the Department will confirm the CD11 matches Department records* and will link the owner
- 4) Once linked, the Owner will be able to request inspections, manage documents or add delegates

*If the information provided on the CD11 does not match Department records, the new owner will be required to file a CD10 and submit a \$100 fee, in addition to submitting the CD11.
