SUBJECT: Licenses for Plumbers, Riggers, Sign Hangers, Oil Burning
Equipment Installers. Section B26-1.7 Administrative Code.


Under the provisions of section B26-1.7 of the Administrative Code, it is required that where a license is used on behalf of a partnership or corporation, all work performed by such partnership or corporation be performed under the direct supervision of the license holder. For those doing plumbing work, it is required that all work be performed under the direct and continuing supervision of the license holder.

As a means of requiring compliance with such requirements for supervision, a license holder shall be restricted in the use of his license on behalf of a partnership or corporation to not more than one such partnership or corporation.

This restriction shall apply to licenses for plumbers, riggers, sign hangers, and oil burning equipment installers, at the time of new issuance of a license or upon renewal of a license.
