

EXPERIENCE IS NOT ENOUGH

To prevent an accident:

- All materials should be kept away from floor or building edges in accordance with Chapter 33.
- All materials should be banded and secured from movement.
- All stripped formwork projected from a building's edge must be secured and removed no later than the next day.
- All formwork and materials must be checked and secured in preparation for high wind and other weather events.

EXPERIENCE IS NOT ENOUGH



Protect the public from potential hazardous conditions.

Properly post required warning signs. Clean floors, sidewalk shed roofs, street or other publicly accessible areas daily. Site Safety managers should maintain accurate safety logs.



Before the start and at the end of work, all edge protection and hole protection such as netting and cocoon systems must be inspected and maintained as needed



Materials not in use should be kept away from edges or openings.



Do not enter or work around an excavated area that is not properly protected, shored or benched.



Properly installed and maintained netting or cocoon systems can save lives.
