

# SERVICE UPDATE

## **2016 NYC Energy Conservation Code in Effect**

---

The **2016 New York City Energy Conservation Code (NYCECC)** has gone into effect **October 3, 2016**, affecting all new buildings and alterations.

### **New Projects**

Jobs filed on or after October 3, 2016 **must** comply with the 2016 NYCECC.

### **Prior Projects**

All job applications with Job Status Code 'D' and Online Code 'A/P Entire' along with complete energy analysis filed on or before October 2, 2016 **must** comply with the 2014 NYCECC.

### **Incomplete Filings**

All job applications with incomplete energy analysis filed on or prior to October 2, 2016 **must** comply with the 2016 NYCECC. Complete applications are those that meet the submittal requirements of Buildings Bulletin 2014-15 and include a complete energy analysis.

### **NYCECC Forms**

All jobs filed on or after October 3, 2016 **must** use the updated forms.

#### Technical Report Statement of Responsibility (TR8)

- Updated selected Energy Code Progress Inspections
- Removed the Applicant's Statement on Commissioning

#### Energy Modeling Worksheet (EN1)

- New excel format with drop-down menus and formulas to aid applicant quality control and expedite Department plan review
- Added the Performance Rating Method methodology option
- 2016 EN1 form must be on the construction documents in the drawing set

#### LAA1 and PW1C

- Updated code references in the statements and signatures sections
