CCRB ADMINISTRATIVE TRIAL ON THE CASE OF KAWASKI TRAWICK'S DEATH TO BEGIN MONDAY

NEW YORK – Monday, the Civilian Complaint Review Board's (CCRB) Administrative Prosecution Unit will begin the trial of Officers Brendan Thompson and Herbert Davis. In 2019, Officers Thompson and Davis wrongfully entered Kawaski Trawick's apartment, tased, shot and killed him. In 2021, the CCRB substantiated misconduct against both officers and the case will now be heard in court. The trial will pause after Tuesday, April 25th and restart on May 11th.
