I write in reply to your email inquiry as to whether or not ██████████ Inc, which is licensed as a second-hand dealer general by the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs ("the Department") to conduct business at ██████████ can receive a temporary second-hand dealer general license to hold a three (3) day jewelry buying event at ██████████ Jewelers, which is located at ██████████. The answer is no.

The Department does not issue a temporary license to a licensed second-hand dealer general for activity of limited duration at another location. Pursuant to Section 20-268(a) of the New York City Administrative Code, "It shall be unlawful for any dealer in second-hand articles to carry on his or her business at any place other than the one designated in such license," You must be licensed as a second-hand dealer general to conduct business at 545 Fifth Avenue.
