## Newsstand License Fee

The chart below lists the amount due depending on the license expiration date you are assigned and when you file your license application. Note: An odd year is any year ending in an odd digit; for example, 2015. An even year is any year ending in an even digit; for example, 2016.

**Exception:** If you are legally blind and submitted Documentation from Physician, you do not need to pay a DCA license fee. However, you must pay a \$1 convenience fee if you submit your license application online.

**Fee Payments**

The DCA Licensing Center accepts payment by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover Card) or check or money order made payable to NYC Department of Consumer Affairs.

If you submit your application online, you must pay with a major credit card.

**Note:** Credit card payments are subject to a nonrefundable 2.49% convenience fee. In the event the payment to which it relates is canceled, refunded, credited, or charged back, you must contact your credit card company to dispute the convenience fee.
