



Required Disclosure Sign – Pregnancy Services Centers

- Pregnancy services centers in New York City must post a disclosure sign that states in English and in Spanish “This facility does not have a licensed medical provider on-site to provide or supervise all services.”
- Centers are responsible for producing and posting the attached required signs, which are 17 inches wide by 11 inches tall.
- Centers must:
 - Post the signs at every public entry to the Center so clients see them.
 - Post the signs on the outside of every entrance door. The distance between the top of the signs and the floor must be between 66 and 70 inches. The distance between the door frame and edges of the signs must be 12 inches or less.
 - Laminate the signs or use other suitable protective material to protect them from wear and tear.
 - Post the signs on the wall in every waiting area. The distance between the top of the signs and the floor must be between 66 and 70 inches. If the waiting area has a Reception desk, the signs must be posted at the Reception desk or on a wall no more than 12 inches from the Reception desk.

This facility does not have a licensed medical provider on-site to provide or supervise all services.
