

File your taxes for FREE!



You may be eligible for up to \$10,000 from tax credits, including the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC).

Join **New York State Senator Adriano Espaillat**, **Council Member Ydanis Rodriguez**, **Commissioner Julie Menin**, and **Triada Stampas**, **Vice President for Research and Public Affairs at Food Bank For New York City** for a special event at the Northern Manhattan Improvement Corporation. At this free City-sponsored tax site run by Food Bank:

- An IRS-certified volunteer will prepare your taxes for you.
- OR**
- You can drop off your tax documents and pick up your completed return at a later date.

To qualify for this free service, you must earn \$53,000 or less. See the back for tax documents to bring to the site.

Tax documents to bring to VITA site:

- Proof of identity (e.g., driver's license or other photo ID)
- Social Security cards for self, spouse, and dependents and/or Social Security number (SSN) verification letters from Social Security Administration OR Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) letters (original or copies)
- Forms W-2, W-2G, 1099-R (wage and earning statements)
- Forms 1098, 1099 (interest and dividend statements)
- Form 1095-A, if you purchased health coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace
- Proof of health coverage exemption granted by the Marketplace, if applicable
- Copy of your 2013 federal and state returns, if available
- Proof of any other income, e.g., lottery winnings
- Total paid for child care provider and provider's Taxpayer Identification Number or SSN
(for NYC Child Care Tax Credit)
- Bank account and routing numbers (to request direct deposit of refund)

For Married Filing Jointly returns, you and your spouse must be present to sign required forms.
