Section D3.3 of the DEP concrete specification requires that all concrete mixes include fly ash (ASTM C618). The DDC Infrastructure Design Division has waived the fly ash requirement for concrete sewer cradles. This waiver is at the contractors option, who must submit for approval the appropriate concrete mix.

Recognizing that there are other incidental uses of concrete delivered for cradle (manhole inverts, type 3 catch basin throats, etc.) such incidental use will be permitted.

However, concrete for all structures including poured in place manholes, box culverts, chambers, etc. must use the DEP specified mix.

All concrete design mixes must be submitted to and approved by DDC QA prior to use.
