When the handling and disposal of existing contaminated/hazardous materials are included in the project scope of work, the Resident Engineer must send the required material handling plan and the contaminated/hazardous Health and Safety Plan (HASP) to the Engineering Services Unit, Program Administration - Infrastructure Division, for review and approval.

In addition, all substantial Overrun and/or Change Order costs, resulting from contaminated/hazardous material handling/disposal work (over \$100,000.00) require Assistant Commissioner review and approval prior to processing.

This policy is to be reviewed with the field staff at preconstruction and critical phase meetings.
