Job Description

The NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS) seeks a Community Associate. The selected candidate under general supervision and with latitude for independent judgment will be responsible for performing work in any phase of program services in the Adult Family intake Center (AFIC). Responsibilities will include, but not necessary be limited to: providing community services to applicants applying for Temporary Housing Assistance (THA); performing liaison functions with site-based programs and units in order to facilitate cooperation and coordination related to THA and/or referrals; preparing daily reports by utilizing information obtained from THA in order to provide shelter placements, as well as completing assignment and activity sheets. S/he will further: coordinate and prepare case files to be submitted for Fair Hearing determination; monitor, track, and report to the unit group supervisor all impacting issues, thus ensuring that all request or concerns are resolved; and be responsible for communicating clearly and effectively with the public and staff. Additionally, the incumbent will be in charged with performing difficult and responsible clerical actions.
