**Job Description**

The NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS) seeks a Plumber for the Trades Unit of the Facility Maintenance & Development Division. Under the direction of the Supervisor Plumber, the selected candidate will perform work relating to the installation, alteration, maintenance, and repair of gas, potable water, plumbing and drainage systems. S/he serves as a licensed plumber. The selected candidate will be responsible for the following: supervising the work of Plumber's Helpers; preparing applications, reports, notices and other documents; obtaining permits and approvals for plumbing work to be performed; and adhering to rules and regulations. In addition, when necessary, s/he will determine and requisition job materials required while work is in process. (4073,4074,4075)

**Qualification Requirements**

(1) Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as a plumber acquired within the last ten years; or  
(2) Not less than three years of full-time satisfactory experience described in "1" above plus sufficient full-time experience as a plumber's helper or apprentice, or training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade school, technical school or vocational high school, to make up the equivalent of five years of acceptable plumber experience.

The apprenticeship must be recognized by the New York State Department of Labor, the U.S. Department of Labor or any apprenticeship council which is recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor. The schooling must be approved by a state's Department of Education or comparable agency. Each year of helper or apprentice experience, or approved schooling is equivalent to six months of satisfactory plumber experience, up to a maximum of two years of satisfactory experience.

Driver License Requirement: You must possess a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York at the time of appointment. If you have moving violations, license suspension or an accident record, you may be disqualified. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.
