

HUNDREDS TURN OUT FOR CAREER FAIR AT YORK COLLEGE



On Saturday, May 7, more than 800 hopefuls came to York College to learn about career opportunities at DOC. The event emphasized non-uniform jobs ranging from cooks and mechanics to social workers and attorneys. Of those who attended, 327 were given on-the-spot interviews. The career fair provided an opportunity to match talented New Yorkers with hundreds of positions currently open.

"With a workforce of more than 10,000, whether you're a cook, a social worker, a mechanic or an attorney, the agency can use your skills," said Commissioner Joseph Ponte. On May 19, the agency will host a Military Career fair for veterans, active-duty military personnel and the spouses of both, at the Fort Hamilton Military Base and another career fair is planned for June 18 at Brooklyn Borough Hall.
