PLEASE READ THIS ADDENDUM CAREFULLY AS THERE HAVE BEEN CHANGES AND CLARIFICATIONS TO THE NEW YORK/NEW YORK III CONGREGATE RFP:

I. CHANGE TO THE RFP

The following language is added to Section II (E), Anticipated Available Annual Funding, and Section III (C5), Site Considerations: "Existing supportive housing programs serving homeless populations currently in operation which receive funding from the City, State or Federal governments will not be considered."

II. UPDATE ON AVAILABLE UNITS

The percentages of remaining, unawarded units by Population Option are as follows:

	Available:
Population I – Chronically homeless single adults with a serious mental illness (1750 units total)	35%
Population II – Chronically homeless families, or families at serious risk of becoming chronically homeless, in which the head of the household has a serious mental illness (400 units total)	55%
Population III – Homeless single adults whose substance use is a primary barrier to independent living (250 units total)	15%
Population V – Chronically homeless families, or families at serious risk of becoming chronically homeless, in which the head of the household has a substance use disorder, a disabling medical condition, or HIV/AIDS (375 units total)	5%
