PLEASE READ THIS ADDENDUM CAREFULLY AS THERE HAVE BEEN CHANGES AND CLARIFICATIONS TO THE NEW YORK/NEW YORK III CONGREGATE RFP:

I. CHANGE TO THE RFP

POPULATION OPTION I – CHRONICALLY HOMELESS SINGLE ADULTS WITH A SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS.

THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) FOR POPULATION OPTION I IS NOW CLOSED.

DOHMH has now awarded contracts for all of the units to be funded under the RFP in **Population Option I**: Chronically Homeless single adults with a serious mental illness. Therefore, DOHMH is no longer accepting proposals for units within Population Option I. DOHMH will continue to accept proposals for Population II and IV until contracts for all units in these Population Options have been awarded.

II. UPDATE ON AVAILABLE UNITS

The approximate percentages of remaining unawarded units by Population Option are as follows:

	Available:
Population II – Chronically homeless families, or families at serious risk of becoming chronically homeless, in which the head of the household has a serious mental illness (400 units total)	58%
Population IV – Homeless single adults who have completed a course of treatment for a substance abuse disorder (125 units total)	20%
