This Addendum revises language in the RFP and in prior Addenda.

- Addenda 10 indicated that the DOHMH is no longer accepting proposals for units in Population Option III (Chronically homeless single adults who have a substance abuse disorder that is a primary barrier to independent living and who also have a disabling clinical condition). DOHMH has re-opened population Option III. Therefore, DOHMH is once again accepting proposals for Population III.
- Addenda 11 indicated that the DOHMH is no longer accepting proposals for units in Population Option I (Chronically homeless single adults who suffer from a serious and persistent mental illness (SPMI) or who are diagnosed as mentally ill and chemically addicted (MICA). DOHMH has re-opened Population Option I. Therefore, DOHMH is once again accepting proposals for Population Option I.

DOHMH will continue to accept proposals for Population Options I, II, III and IV until contracts for all units in these Population Options have been awarded. The units remaining are as follows:

<b>Population Option</b>	<b>Units Available</b>
Population Option I- Chronically homeless single adults who suffer from a serious and persistent mental illness (SPMI) or who are diagnosed as mentally ill and chemically addicted (MICA)	<b>43</b>
Population Option II- Chronically homeless families, or families at serious risk of becoming chronically homeless, in which the head of the household suffers from SPMI or a MICA disorder	<b>58</b>
Population Option III- Chronically homeless single adults who have a substance abuse disorder that is a primary barrier to independent living and who also have a disabling clinical condition	<b>2</b>
Population Option IV- Homeless single adults who have completed a course of treatment for a substance abuse disorder and are at risk of street homelessness or sheltered homelessness and who need supportive housing to sustain sobriety and achieve independent living	<b>9</b>
