



Getting Services While Chelsea Clinic is Closed for Renovation

Key Information

- Renovation work at the Health Department's Chelsea STD clinic at 303 9th Avenue continues.
- The clinic has relocated to the Riverside STD Clinic on the Upper West Side (160 West 100th St., between Amsterdam and Columbus Aves.) **Operating hours are Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Saturdays 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., and (for HIV counseling and testing) Tuesdays and Thursdays, 5 to 7 p.m.; closes at noon the first Wednesday of each month.**
- HIV/STD services are available from mobile clinics, located near the Chelsea clinic entrance. The **NYC Health Department Help Station** (open Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) will provide updated mobile clinic hours and other full service options in the area.
