**Subject:** HEARING TO REPEAL ARTICLES 111 AND 117 OF THE NEW YORK CITY HEALTH CODE

To whom it may concern:

As a part of the supply network for SUBWAY® Restaurants within the 5 boroughs of New York City, I am compelled to urge repeal articles 111 and 117 of the New York City Health Code.

These dating regulations do not recognize nor allow the buying public nor the retailers to take advantage of technology enhancements that assure public safety. Ultra High Temperature pasteurization assures that the milk drinking public can safely consume milk for up to 100 days past the date of pasteurization.

Additionally, these articles result in waste and revenue losses for SUBWAY® franchisees. These independent business persons are forced to discard milk that has 45 days of shelf life remaining. In today's economy and keeping a mind to sound business practices, it makes no sense to continue to discard perfectly good milk products.

I urge you to repeal these articles.
