





Children Referred and Found Eligible, by Borough FY09-FY11


"Referred" column includes all children referred to the program during that time period.

"Found eligible" column includes all children from that referral cohort that were evaluated and found eligible.




Children Authorized for Services, by Borough FY09-FY11

Services include general services, respite, transportation, and assistive technology




Age at Time of Referral FY08-FY11


Domains of Delay Among Children Entering the NYC Early Intervention Program FY08 - FY11

Children < 18 Months Old at Initial IFSP





Mean Number of Basic vs. Extended Units of General Services* Authorized Per Child Per Week





Authorization of Special Instruction Among Children in the New York City Early Intervention Program

Cohort: Children who were referred to NYC EIP in 2009, were found eligible, and received services other than screening, evaluation and/or service coordination.

The analysis includes all services authorized during the child's tenure in NYC EIP, from 2009 through 2011.

Total number of children = 16,636



Note: 99.9% of the 1,844 children with PDD/ASD were authorized for special instruction.
